MUSIC THEORY & FUNDAMENTALS

- Introduction to the Modes of the Harmonic/Melodic Minor scales, & other exotic scales; and the usage of phrasing, improvisation, and building melodic lines
- An understanding of Jazz Harmony & relevant resolutions, chord substitutions, and altered harmony
- Developing in-depth knowledge of scales/modes and their uses
- Deep knowledge of tone - both acoustic and electric - and all the components of producing great tone for a variety of styles and musical situations.
- The ability to produce a recording - either as a solo or an ensemble
- Developing the tools and techniques in composition, to write in different genres, and the development of a compositional style



EAR TRAINING

- Ability to identify complex chords, inversions & voicings with accuracy
- Ability to work in solo/duo/trio and ensemble formats, with the flexibility to accompany, lead, solo, comp, etc., with fluency, sensitivity and dynamics.



MUSCULAR TRAINING

- Alternate picking: 1/16 notes at 180 & 200 bpm; flexibility to work with various finger combinations at varying tempos, rhythmic subdivisions, swing, etc.
- Comprehensive grasp of techniques on both acoustic and electric guitar.



SIGHT READING

- Sight-reading pieces from RSL Grade 6



SONG LEARNING

- Ability to play at least 50 songs in a variety of styles, with an in-depth understanding of genre-specific technique
- Ability to play RSL Grade 7/8 pieces fluently and well
- Ability to transcribe at least 30 guitar solos with accuracy



IMPROVISATION

- Ability to improvise fluently through simple and complex changes in a variety of musical styles - from pop and rock to blues and jazz and beyond, with the right sensitivity, dynamics and 'feel'.
- Ability to build coherent, spontaneous solos and harmony/revoicing while playing with ensembles.



LIVE PERFORMANCE

- Regular performances at school/college/semi-pro/Taaqademy events

- RSL Awards Grade 7/8 (depending on ability/practice); Trinity Rock & Pop Grade 8 (depending on ability/practice)

HOW LONG WILL THIS TAKE?

This question gets asked a lot! Allow us to give you a simple rule-of-thumb:

- At this level, if you **consistently** practice an avg. **1 - 2 hr. per day**, you can expect to have covered the above in **10 - 12 months (40 - 48 classes)**.
- If you practice around **4 hrs. per week**, this could **add 4 - 5 months**.
- If you practice **<1 hr. per week**, you could take **18+ months!**
- **Actually speaking, once you're at this level, you KNOW it takes forever. As in, your whole life. And that is good :-).**
